Regional Politicians and Thought Leaders to Speak at the 11th Hitachi Young Leaders Initiative

- Into its 11th edition, the Hitachi Young Leaders Initiative demonstrates Hitachi's commitment towards grooming young Asian leaders

Kuala Lumpur, October 25, 2011 – Hitachi Asia Ltd. (NYSE: HIT / TSE:6501) today announced the confirmed list of speakers and students who will represent Malaysia at the 11th Hitachi Young Leaders Initiative (HYLI). The event, which will be held in Hanoi, Vietnam from 9 to 13 January 2012, will see the gathering of regional politicians and key thought leaders from the region.

Malaysia is the only participating country whereby two thought leaders have been invited to speak at the programme. Ir. Ahmad Fauzi Bin Hasan, Chief Executive Officer of Energy Commission will be speaking on *Seeking Sustainable Energy Options*, while Datuk Dr. Rebecca Fatima Sta Maria, Secretary General of Ministry of International Trade and Industry will be speaking on *Moving Towards an Economically-Integrated Community*.

Since its inauguration in 1996, HYLI has been successful in bringing the best and brightest students in Asia together. Each year, four outstanding students below the age of 28 are chosen to represent their country for the programme. These students come from seven Asian countries namely Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam and Japan.

As a regional programme, HYLI aims to provide a platform for young Asians to gather and meet prominent Asian policymakers, professionals and commentators to discuss and share ideas on trends which affect Asia.

Mr. Toshiaki Kuzuoka, Senior Vice President and Executive Officer, Hitachi, Ltd. said, "The line-up of speakers for the 11th HYLI impresses with their prominence and standing in the Asian community. The 10 shortlisted student applicants were put through a rigorous selection process based on their academic results, participation in extra-curricular activities, awards achieved and knowledge of current regional issues.

- Ong Kit Wee Faculty of Law at Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia, majoring in Intellectual Property, Corporate Finance, Sales of Goods Act, International Trade Law.
- 4. Donald Anak Stephen Faculty of Cognitive Sciences and Human Development at Universiti Malaysia Sarawak.

Choo Hong Ning from Universiti Putra Malaysia, said, "I am thrilled to be selected to participate in this highly prestigious programme. I look forward to the chance to mingle and learn from these leaders from the region; and also to share experience with other students in the region."
