The judges then selected those with the highest scores for placement in the categories: Global 75 (for those with a global footprint); Regional 20 (for those who clearly dominate in Asia); and Rising Stars (for the five fairly young companies that appear to be driving major technology developments and deployment trends, moving forward).

The 2011 Strategic 100 honourees received their commemorative plaques at an event in Hong Kong at the Pier 7 Café & Bar on November 23, and in Singapore at ARDENT'S Cafe Bar on December 8.

Separately, Hitachi's leading system management software JP1 had bagged two other awards recently.

In October 2011, Hitachi's JP1 won the Best IT Asset Management System award at the Computerworld Malaysia 10th Readers Choice Awards 2011. Commonly acknowledged as the 'Oscars of the IT industry', the awards go to vendors, products, services or solution families that score the highest with



their customers who voted in the areas of price, performance, feature sets, reliability and ease of use.

In November 2011, Hitachi's JP1 was awarded the Best Server Infrastructure Management Solution/Tool award at the 2011 Network World Asia Readers' Choice Product Excellence Awards. The awards are conferred based on votes from readers of Network World Asia magazine, and the Networks Asia, Security Asia and Storage Asia websites.
